SUBJECT: Procedural Change, Certain Generally Licensed Radioactive Devices

The Air Force Radioisotope Committee (RIC) changed procedures for permitting certain generally licensed devices containing materials. Many devices previously requiring a radioactive material permit now only require registration with the RIC. The attached AFMOA/CC letter provides further guidance on procedural changes and registration procedures. These devices include gas chromatographs, isoscans, some gauges and some static eliminators. The RIC will contact organizations that no longer require a permit and provide them with instructions on terminating permits.

In addition, owning organizations must now register certain generally licensed materials (e.g., exit signs) with the RIC no later than 31 Dec 01. The bioenvironmental engineering flight shall determine if there are devices on base that require registration, and if so ensure the owning organization registers them. All registration actions must be coordinated through bioenvironmental engineering.
