SUBJECT: Command Core System (CCS) Implementations

1. As the appointed designated approval authority (DAA) for the AETC enterprise network and as the Deputy Chief Information Officer (CIO), it is my duty to ensure both the health and well being of our networks and the systems attaching to them. My staff, in conjunction with the SG staff, have reviewed the various system security and deployment issues surrounding CCS. We have documented our review IAW AETC Supplement 1, AFI 33-103; results are at: <http://www.aetc.af.mil/sc/scx/s02t0008.htm#ccs>.

2. CCS is given an interim approval to operate (IATO) within the command (valid for a period of one year from the date of this letter). CCS has met all the AETC networkiness and sustainability requirements except where indicated below:

a. Until the release of CCS 4.2, local system administrators must enforce password policy IAW AFMAN 33-223.

b. Upgrade the relational database software to Oracle v8i, which employs shared-socket communications rather than port-hopping under Oracle v 7.0.

Upon implementation of these required changes, final approval to operate can be granted.

3. A copy of the CCS certification and accreditation package is on file with the AETC NOSC security office. The base MTF units will need to work with the local communications units to complete local accreditation and certification of the system for approval to operate on each base. The current implementation schedule is attached.
