SUBJECT: Visibility of Homeland Defense (HLD) Projects in Medical Readiness Decision Support System (MRDSS)

1. In accordance with the attached HQ USAF/SGX memo, dated 28 Mar 03, please ensure you are entering the status of all fielded Homeland Defense projects including the recently approved HLD BEE Detection Team package, AS 886H. Our long-term tool for management of these projects will be Defense Medical Logistics Support System (DMLSS). DMLSS is currently operational at two ACC bases and will continue to be fielded across the Air Force over the next 3 years. For those bases where DMLSS is operational (Minot and Nellis), use DMLSS as your project management tool now. All others must use the MRDSS Unit Input Module (UIM) as described in the SGX memo.

2. Approved Homeland Defense Allowance Standards (AS) currently on the AFMLO website, <https://afml.ft-detrick.af.mil/afmlo/index.cfm>, include:

AS Number	Designation
886A	In Place Patient Decontamination (IPPD)
886B	Laboratory Response Team (LRT)
886D	In-patient Follow-on Medical Response
886H	Bioenvironmental Engineering Surveillance

The Initial Medical Response and Pharmaceutical ASs are the only remaining draft modules and will be finalized in the next coming months.
