SUBJECT: Request for Plan to Address AF Issues with the DOHRS-HC Data Repository

The DOHRS data repository currently does not satisfy AF business practices. AF audiometric data is not available for queries or reports; our installations must have this data to manage their Hearing Conservation programs. The AF Hearing Conservation Data Registry (HCDR) contains only pre Oct 99 data. The HCDR office has a backlog of data query requests from the field and has had to deny AF STS requests and requests for OSHA reportable shift rates. In addition, AF end of year statistics on program compliance will not be available until AF data is available through the DOHRS data repository.

The canceled the 6-17 March 2000 data warehouse reporting capabilities testing means that we still haven't had a full scale test on a completely populated data registry. We view successful reporting capabilities testing as crucial to AF acceptance of the program. Likewise, a strong ad hoc reporting capability is important to us. The lack of ad hoc reporting capabilities means that we are unable to monitor the base level data uploads: making it difficult to determine AF HC program compliance status.

We need to ensure that the AF maintains an adequate HCDR. So that we can better work together to resolve AF issues, please forward your plan and schedule to me for addressing these concerns as soon as possible.
