SUBJECT: Follow-up request For Your Plan to Address USAF Issues on DOEHRS-HC Data Repository

This is a follow-up to my memo dated 27 March 2000 concerning AF audiometric data not available for queries or reports. To reiterate my concerns, the AF Hearing Conservation Data Registry (HCDR) has a significant, and growing, backlog of data query requests from the field. Because this information is not available, we also cannot compile the AF end-of-year statistics on program compliance, STS data, OSHA reportable shift rates, and other pertinent HC data. Therefore, we are unable to assess overall program effectiveness.

I previously asked you to forward a plan and schedule to me for addressing these pressing issues as soon as possible. I have not yet received anything in writing outlining a solution. I must now request that your office provide me a means of extracting hearing conservation data from the DOEHRS module, as well as the data dictionary, so that our folks at the HCDR can support higher headquarters' requests.

We need to resolve these issues now so that the HCDR can better work with base level units and provide the AF with up-to-date data for reporting vital statistics and trends. Please contact me at DSN 574-1209 for immediate action. My POC from AF HCDR is Capt Shull at DSN 240-2940
