SUBJECT: Visibility of Homeland Defense (HLD) Projects in the Medical Readiness Decision Support System (MRDSS)

Effective 15 April 03, all units assigned a Homeland Defense Bioenvironmental Engineering (BEE) Detection Team package will update status of these projects in MRDSS using the Unit Input Module (UIM). This reporting is in addition to UIM updates already required for Homeland Defense RAPID and Weapons of Mass Destruction 1st Responder In-Place Patient Decontamination packages. As other Homeland Defense projects are fielded in the coming months, it is expected units will also report their status via the UIM.

All data must be updated using the UIM, including medical materiel on-hand balances. Because these projects are funded with operations and maintenance funds, they cannot be managed in MEDLOG or DMLSS. Therefore, the automated process used to input War Reserve Materiel UTCs status in MRDSS cannot be utilized.

Team leaders are responsible for accomplishing monthly asset inventories and providing results to their medical readiness flights. Medical readiness personnel will make the appropriate changes to the UIM materiel screen when they enter their regular monthly updates to the system.
