SUBJECT: Air Force Medical Service (AFMS) Occupational and Environmental Health
Informational Management

Command Core System (CCS) is the AFMS legacy system for environmental and occupational health programs. CCS supports the Defense Occupational Health Readiness System (DOHRS) concept, standardizing exposure data throughout the Department of Defense. CCS must be used for storage, archival, retrieval and analysis of occupational health data.

The use of other occupational health systems whose functions are found in CCS should be immediately curtailed coupled with aggressive transition to CCS. AFMOA/SGOE will work with AFIA to monitor and report the integration of CCS into daily operations, an essential milestone to furthering the DOHRS concept.
